Words from a Scholarship Recipient

Hello!! I am honored to have the opportunity to share life after receiving the Rusk High School Alumni Association Scholarship! My name is Crystal Nichols, but many in my hometown know me as Crystal Henderson. I received the Rusk High School Alumni Association Scholarship in 2006. I attended my freshman year of college at the University of North Texas before transferring to Stephen F. Austin State University. In 2010, I graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Interdisciplinary Studies, Early Childhood - 6th grade. After graduation, I taught Kindergarten and 2nd grade in Katy, Texas. Soon after, I knew the best place to be was home. I returned to Rusk and continued my career as a 6th grade ELA teacher at Rusk Junior High. In my second year as

Lester Hughes RHSAA Educator the Year

Mr. Hughes acquired his job by unusual circumstances. He did not *interview* for his job of band director at Rusk ISD. In July 1961 Gerald Chapman and Mack Philbrick showed up to Lester Hughes' class at Stephen F. Austin College. Having already talked with Lester's college band director, teacher, and former employer, they offered Lester the job as they were anxious to get someone hired by August in time for band practices. Hughes, having never been to Rusk agreed to come over the next week and sign a contract.

Lester was born in Center, Texas and was raised on a farm outside of Center in the community of Arcadia. He was born into a musical family. His mother played the piano and sang, and his daddy taught gospel

singing schools.

Lester was drum major in high school and in college for three years while he received his bachelor's degree in music and his fourth year he received his master's degree in education at SFA. He also attended Arizona State University and University of Hawaii a couple of summers. At age 22, Hughes began his career at Rusk High School. Many have said that when Lester first arrived, they thought he was a new student because he looked a very young 22 years old.

Not long after arriving in Rusk, Lester was invited by a friend to the First United Methodist Church, where he has been a proud member ever since. Lester has served as interim choir director six different times. Lester was also an active member of the Lions Club in the 1970s -80s.

When school integration began, Lester was asked to teach two band periods a day at the G. W. Bradford School during the school year 1967-68. In addition to band directing, he also taught driver's education at Rusk, Cushing, and Central Heights.

Lester married in his early 30s to Fay Birkelbach, who had graduated from Rusk in 1960 before Lester started teaching. Lester and Fay had two daughters, Cynthia and Adriene, who both followed in the band tradition, as well as being baton twirlers and drum majors in the band.

Lester and Fay have been blessed with grand-daughter, Marilyn and grandson, Cooper. And last year they became great-grandparents to Anderson. After nineteen years of teaching, Hughes went to work at Citizens 1st Bank in Rusk for 12 years. Later Lester wanted to complete his teacher retirement years and went to work for the Windham School System at the Coffield Prison Unit in Tennessee Colony, Texas. He also worked there for 12 years and retired at the age of 61. During his tenure at Coffield, he bought Rusk Mini Storage from Travis McCain and later purchased storage units from Tom Ball. He continued and increased the business for 23 years.

On April 24th, 2020, Hughes sold his two storage building sites to My Garage Self Storage. He and the family have laughed because several have asked, "What is he going to do now?" Because at the age of 81, Lester has more than earned the privilege of doing what he wants most days....which still includes rent houses, but also includes reading lots of books, watching westerns on T.V., and visiting with people on the phone.

Lester said "I have enjoyed every moment in Rusk and especially the people. I hope to remain in Rusk the rest of my life."

By the way, he has plots in Rusk's Cedar Hill Cemetery.
